## DOT INSPECTION

A DOT inspection is a series of tests that assess the condition of commercial motor vehicles (CMVs) to ensure they are safe and compliant with regulations. The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) conducts these inspections to help keep roads safe and prevent accidents

## COOLANT INSPECTION

A coolant inspection, also known as a cooling system inspection, involves checking the coolant level, chemical balance, and for contaminants like oil or rust. It also assesses hoses, belts, the radiator cap, water pump, and cooling fan for damage or wear. Regular inspections can help prevent engine overheating and other issues, with service recommended every 30,000 miles or per manufacturer guidelines.

## AC INSPECTION

A commercial truck’s air conditioning system should be regularly inspected for leaks, worn components, and loose connections to avoid major breakdowns and ensure proper cooling. Key areas to check include the compressor clutch, refrigerant charge, belts, hoses, and the evaporator core. A visual inspection for damage or leaks, and monitoring the sight glass in R-134a systems, can help diagnose refrigerant issues. Regular maintenance ensures consistent performance and prevents costly repairs.
